Jackson has once again joined forces with the charitable organization, this time to help raise funds for urgent flood relief in British Columbia. With The Huron Carole celebrating its 34th year sparking the true spirit of the season in Canadians coast to coast, audiences can tune into the annual variety show and fundraiser online this Friday to enjoy performances from Jackson and a bevy of his musical friends, as well as Christmas classics, stories from the road, timeless fables, original music, Jackson's signature Dad jokes, and more — all for a good cause...

"This has been a strenuous near-two years for Canadians, and the world — and especially our neighbours in British Columbia with respect to recent disastrous flooding, on top of forest fires and climate events," Jackson says. "Together with the Canadian Red Cross, it is our hope to provide this unticketed viewing of The Huron Carole: Angels Without Wings as a gift of virtual gathering, celebration, and reflection on what the true spirit of the season means to us all.

"We are encouraging donations in support of our neighbours in BC, but there is no expectation," he continues. "Excitingly, our Canadian Federal government and the British Columbia Provincial government are set to match donations on all funds raised through to Sunday, December 26th."

Pat Quealey, Vice President British Columbia & Yukon, Canadian Red Cross commented, "We want to let you know that all of your support is going to be beneficial in helping people out with their immediate needs and their long journey of recovery which we commit to being with them. The complete family of the Red Cross includes you as donors and we're hopeful that we can do good work here on your behalf."

Being a long-time Ambassador for the Red Cross, The Huron Carole — and this December 24th's event — come full circle for Jackson, in more ways than one. Named 'Angels Without Wings,' this year's title harks to his storied steps into humanitarian efforts that have resulted in coordinating more than \$230 million in funds and in-kind services to an abundance of charities and relief organizations including food banks, women's shelters, mental health programs and other initiatives in the communities it visits coast to coast.

Holding court with a global audience beyond Canadian screens is something Tom Jackson has sweeping experience with; with countless marquee TV roles to his credit — including North of

60, Shining Time Station, Star Trek: The Next Generation, Law & Order, Outlander, and Cardinal — he's also held roles in movies such as Cold Pursuit, Deadfall, Mee-Shee: The Water Giant, and Grizzly Falls. As for music — a passion he cites as his first love — Jackson recently released the poignant song, "[Lost Souls](#)," on Canada's inaugural National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, as well as The Essential Tom Jackson, a dazzling two-disc, 21-track retrospective spotlighting his inimitable talent as a folk-pop singer/songwriter.

Bridging his work as an artist and activist, he launched and hosted Almighty Voices at the onset of COVID-19; the 12-week virtual series featured a veritable who's who roster of talent and voices, all in support of the Unison Benevolent Fund. With an indefatigable energy to be on the look-out for those in need, and an innate ability to respond to unexpected crises, the series was yet another laudable example of how the act of giving comes naturally and spreads easily for Jackson.

The recipient of 11 honorary degrees, Jackson also volunteers with Calgary's DOAP Team (Downtown Outreach Addictions Partnership), is a recipient of both the 2007 JUNO and Gemini Humanitarian Awards, and holds the Governor General's Performing Arts Award for Lifetime Artistic Achievement.

Tom Jackson was promoted to Companion of the Order of Canada in 2021 — the highest designation within the Order. "When I was appointed an Officer of the Order of Canada in 2000, I questioned why at the time," he reveals. "Since then, this promotion to rank of Companion is validating the work my team has done for many decades. And that work has converted the word of love to the verb of love."
